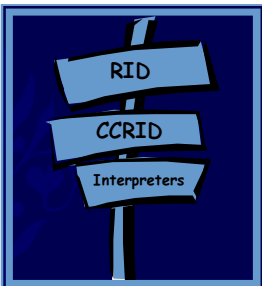

Wow...is it summer already?? The triple digits are too soon in coming!

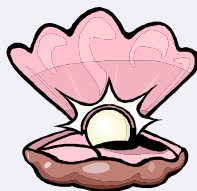

Lakewood Elementary School in Modesto was the proud host to two amazing American Sign Language performances on Sunday, March 30 by Tim Hickerson and Amanda Folendorf.

Tim Hickerson, a Lodi resident, passionately interpreted songs from musical artists such as ABBA, Elton John, the Bee Gees, and Elton John. Tim began performing at the age of 3 and has continued to perform through his life. He graduated from the California School for the Deaf in Fremont. Tim's fluidity, facial expressions and dramatic ability to make music accessible to the Deaf community is quite a gift.

The event also included a performance by Amanda Folendorf, the current Miss Deaf California. Twenty-one year old Amanda was raised in Angels Camp and was a 2004 graduate from Bret Harte High School. While living in Angels Camp, Amanda was active in sports and community events. She attended Gallaudet University from 2004-2006 then transferred to California State University, Sacramento where she is majoring in International Relations. She plans to graduate in 2009. Amanda became involved in the Miss Deaf California pageant for the enriching experience, to gain many memories, and to meet wonderful people. At the event she performed an interpreted poem about her life experiences which was very moving. In June she will be traveling to New Orleans for the Miss Deaf America competition. The RID Region V conference is approaching quickly. The conference, set for September 24 –September 28, will be held at the Holiday Inn education ■ standards ■ excellence Capitol Plaza in Sacramento, CA.

We will have yet another close to home conference which means that more of us will be able to attend. In keeping with the history of the location, this year's theme will be "Discover Your Gold!" and will allow for many opportunities for certified interpreters to earn CEUs and for pre-certified interpreters to improve their skills.



Below are more details about the conference in order to assist you with planning.

Early bird registration closes on June 14 so be sure to register before that to get the discount member price of \$185. Region V has also secured a group reservation rate with the Holiday Inn of \$119 single/\$129 double-quad; when making your hotel reservation you must use the group reservation code UR5 in order to get that price. Tickets to the Saturday night banquet can be purchased with registration at the cost of \$40 or for \$50 at the door (if they have not sold out).

As with many major cities the parking may be limited so please consider car pooling or taking public transportation to the conference. Self parking at the hotel is \$12 per day and valet parking is \$18 per day. If you are interested in taking public transportation there is an Amtrak station located in walking distance from the hotel.

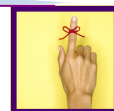
